Lewis Janitorial Supply Proud of Success. Thanks Employees, Customers, Suppliers and Friends for Their Support.

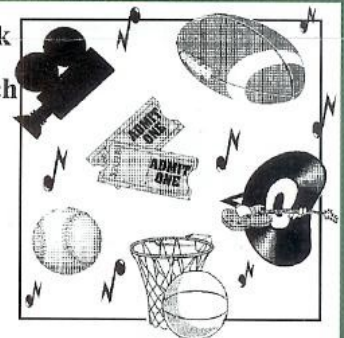

What Else Happened in 1981?

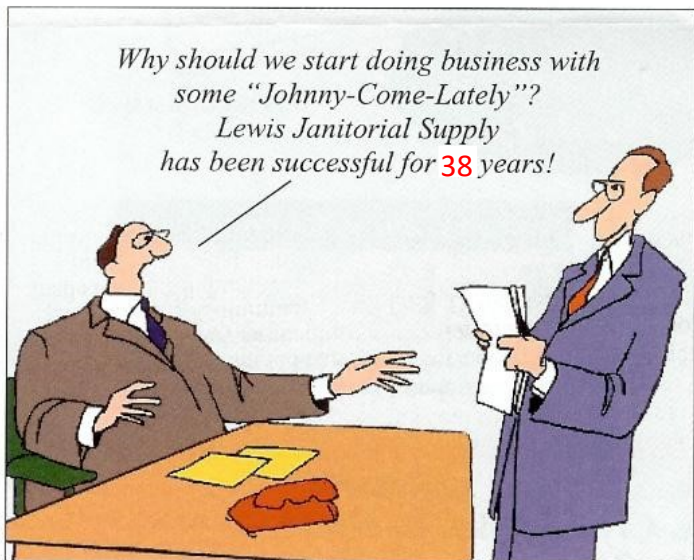
